9. Executive Director's Report

500 N. Delaware (Jones Creek Preserve)

Mr. Chaison reported that there was a small brush fire (approximately 0.25 acres) that occurred at the former Taylor property on January 6th. Palm Beach County Fire Rescue and

Jupiter Police Department responded to the call. Mr. Chaison has requested a copy of the report and stated that no official cause has been identified.

Loxahatchee River Railroad Bridge – Enhanced Clearance Span:

The Enhanced Clearance Span is fully installed and removal of the old foundation under the span is underway. Mr. Chaison is coordinating confirmation of the elevations and bathymetry.

2023 Sand Trap Dredging:

The bid solicitation for the 2023 Sand Trap Dredging will be covered in the Engineer's Report. In addition to the traditional method of advertising, the District has posted the bid on the JID website.

District Relevant Permit Activity:

A permit application was submitted for 1116 Love Street. This is for dredging at Charlie and Joe's for the area between their floating dock and the ICWW to -8' MLW.

North Jetty Handrail Replacement:

Murray Logan Construction has been approached for replacement of the damaged handrail along the north jetty. Mr. Chaison stated the handrails have been removed from the Jetty. Costs and scheduling are being coordinated. Murry Logan will be able to reuse handrails, as they were not damaged. Mr. Gentile inquired whether the welded joints were faulty which led to the failure. Mr. Craig stated the joints were overstressed and no change needs to be made in the design.

U.S 1 Bridge

Mr. Chaison is coordinating with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to tentatively present an update on bridge construction at the March Board Meeting.

10. Engineer's Report

General Engineering

Jetty Observation

Mr. Craig performed the Jetty Observations on January 11th. He noted more shoreline retreat along the south beach, which is typical for this time of year.

Loxahatchee River Mile 6 Gap Closure and Oxbow Restoration Maintenance:

Mr. Craig stated that there has been no change in the status of the application.

Jupiter Inlet Jetties Restoration:

Mr. Craig stated there should be an update at the February Board Meeting.

Jupiter Inlet Sand Trap Dredging 2023:

The Sand Trap Dredging has been advertised and to date, there have been sixteen entities and twelve dredging companies that have downloaded the project packet. Bids will be presented on February 6th and Taylor Engineering will have a recommendation at the February Board Meeting.

Sediment Study 2023:

Mr. Craig stated Taylor Engineering had an internal kick off meeting for the Sediment Study to assign tasks and schedule field work. The next steps include working with Mr. Chaison to set up a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC). There will be two meetings- at the beginning and end of the study. Mr. Gentile asked if any of the construction happening on the waterways will affect the Sediment Study. Mr. Craig said it shouldn't affect the Inlet portion of the study, but will possibly need to be evaluated for the river portion of the study.

11. Legal Report

The Local Bill will be presented to the Local Delegation on January 12th. Mr. Pinsky showed the Bill to bill drafting, who suggested a few format changes. Mr. Broome stated that he has reviewed these changes and nothing of substance has been altered. Representative Snyder has agreed to sponsor the Bill.





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State Beach and Inlet Local Government Funding Program:

After extensive coordination, our reimbursement request from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) has been paid. The \$1,518,525 check was cut on January 26th and is anticipated to have arrived by the time of this meeting.

500 N. Delaware Property Deed:

The Deed between the Town of Jupiter and the Jupiter Inlet District was recorded on January 24th and is included in this meeting packet. Staff have been coordinating with the Town of Jupiter regarding demolition of the remaining deteriorating on-site structures.

North Jetty Handrail Replacement:

Murray Logan Construction submitted a cost of \$5,950 to replace the damaged handrail section and have been authorized to perform the work. They were able to recover most of the damaged sections and plan to reuse these sections for the repair.

2023 Loxahatchee River / Jupiter Inlet Biennial Boat Tour:

We have confirmed availability of the Loxahatchee Queen for our biennial boat tour. This is the same vessel we used in 2021. We are planning for the same general format, noticing, and duration as our last tour. We want to confirm availability of JID Commissioners before initiating the invitations. We are considering the following dates; March 28, 29, April 4, 5, 18, or 19.

Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse Shoreline Project / Sawfish Bay and Island Projects:

I have compiled some drawings depicting proposed and ongoing projects to show during the meeting. These projects are; Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse Shoreline Stabilization by the Bureau of Land Management, Sawfish Bay Marine Restoration by the Town of Jupiter, and Sawfish Island Restoration by Palm Beach County.

1922 Inlet Dredging Blueprint:

I wanted to share an original copy of our 1922 inlet dredging blueprint that was spotted during office organizing efforts. Staff have priced framing this document and want to determine consensus of the board for preserving this blueprint.

Florida Shore and Beach Protection Association Conference:

I attended the Florida Shore and Beach Protection Association (FSBPA) Technical Conference in Ft. Myers on February $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$. I used the opportunity to schedule an informal meeting with the FDEP to discuss our Inlet Management Plan update.



Jupiter Inlet District Monthly Engineering Report February 2023

General Engineering

Jetty Observation

Taylor Engineering staff (Ken Craig) will perform the monthly jetty condition assessment on February 8. We will report on any significant changes from the prior assessment.

North Jetty Railing Repairs

Murray Logan provided a very reasonable cost (\$5,950) to repair the north jetty railing. Once repairs are complete, Taylor Engineering will review work and provide our assessment to JID.

Loxahatchee River Mile 6 Gap Closure and Oxbow Restoration Maintenance

The USACE issued public notice on July 20, 2022 and provided copies to JID and Taylor Engineering. The public notice 30-day comment period closed on August 19, 2022. The USACE received comments from the U.S. Coast Guard and National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS). As a result of comments received, the USACE issued a second request for additional information (RAI) on August 22, 2022. Taylor Engineering has provided all requested information listed in the RAI including the alternatives analysis to the USACE for review. There has been no change since the last report.

Jupiter Inlet Jetties Restoration

Due to significant volatility in the marine construction market, Taylor Engineering continues to coordinate with material suppliers. We plan to move forward with 90% drawings in the next month.

Jupiter Inlet Sand Trap Dredging 2023

Taylor Engineering posted the advertisement for a dredging contractor on January 3. Bid opening is scheduled for 2PM on February 6 at the JID office. We will review all bids received and make a recommendation to the board regard award at the February board meeting.

Jupiter Inlet Sediment Budget Update

Taylor Engineering continues to work with Mr. Chaison to schedule the first Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) meeting. We are currently targeting February 22 to hold a combined in-person (JID office) and virtual (Zoom) meeting with TAC members. We also worked with Mr. Chaison to define the scope of the bathymetric survey and plan to review the proposal from Terraquatic when available. Sediment sampling field work is scheduled to occur this month. We continue to review past reports, compile relevant information for the study, and organize spatial data in a structured geodatabase for future use.
